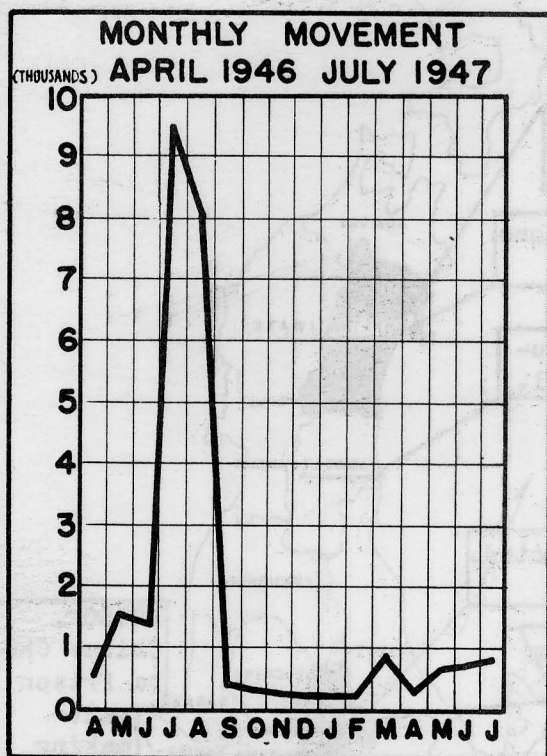
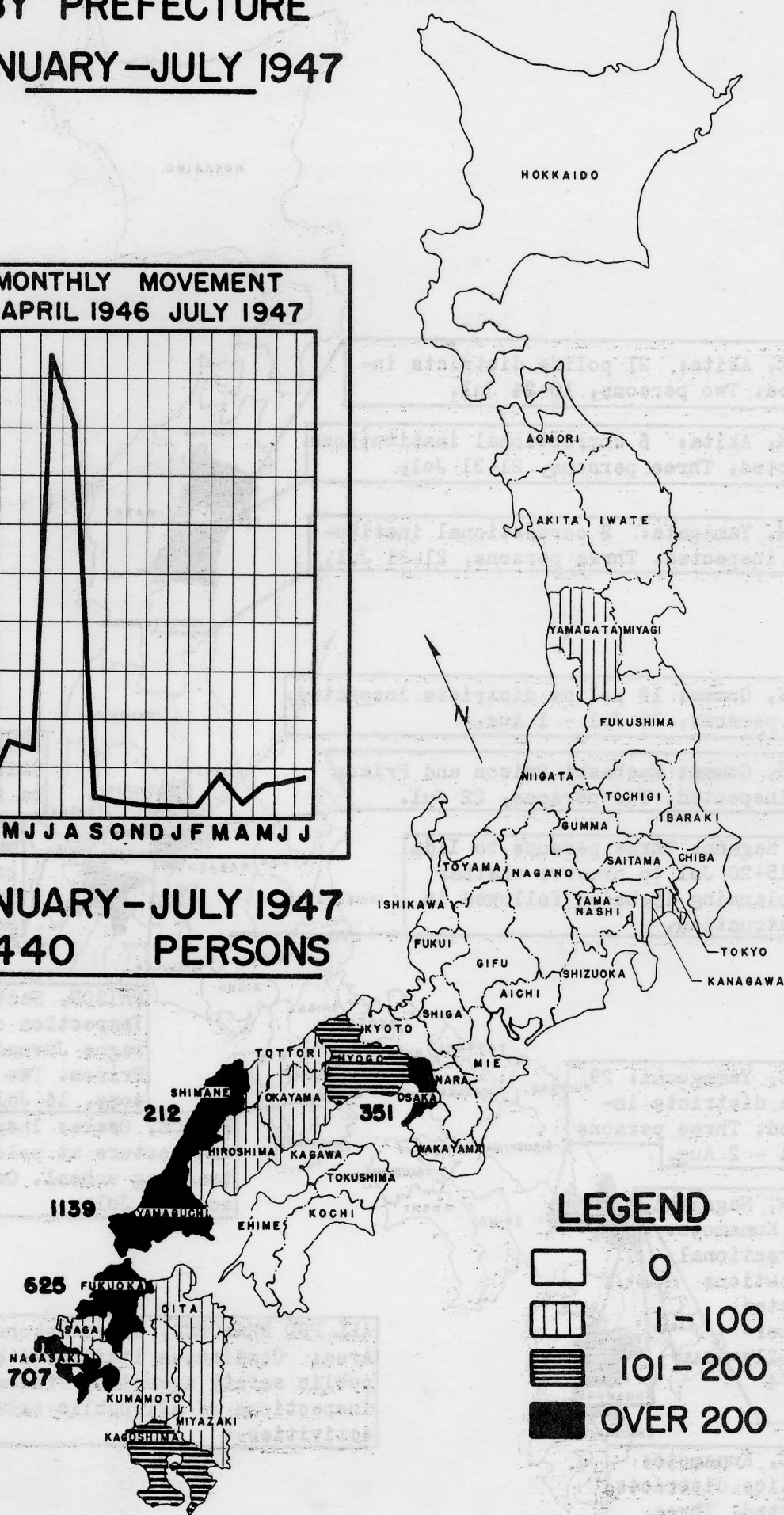

PRISON, Akita: 6 correctional institutions inspected. Three persons, 21-31 Jul.

POLICE, Gumma: 19 police districts inspected. Three persons, 18 Jul - 1 Aug.

PRISON, Gumma: Maebashi Prison and Prison Farm inspected. Two persons, 22 Jul.

FIRE, Nagano: Three persons to Iida City 15-20 Jul to observe whether city planning is being followed in reconstruction.

ALL PSD BRANCHES, Tokyo-Yokohama Area: Continuous liaison with all public safety agencies; frequent inspections of all public safety activities.

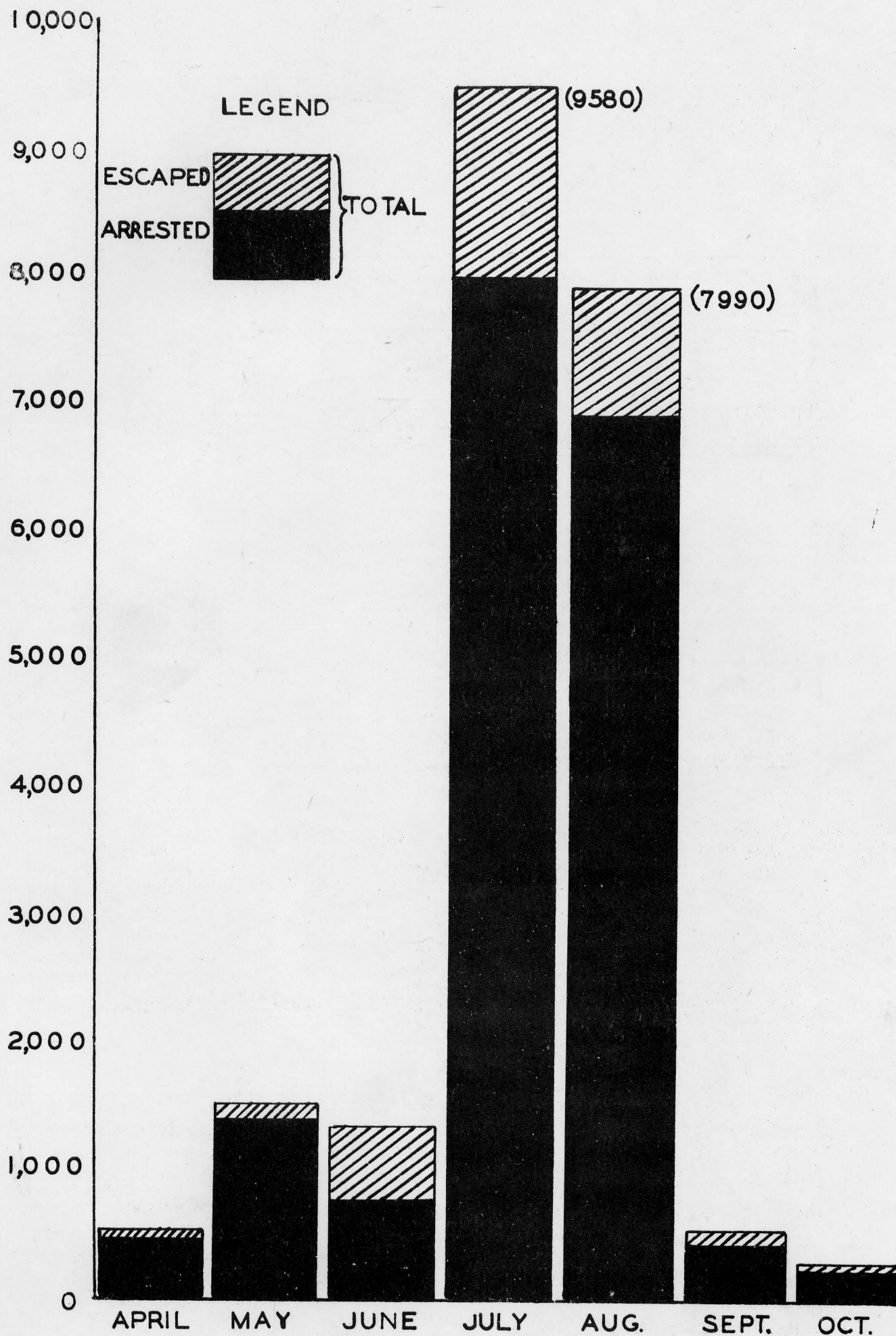

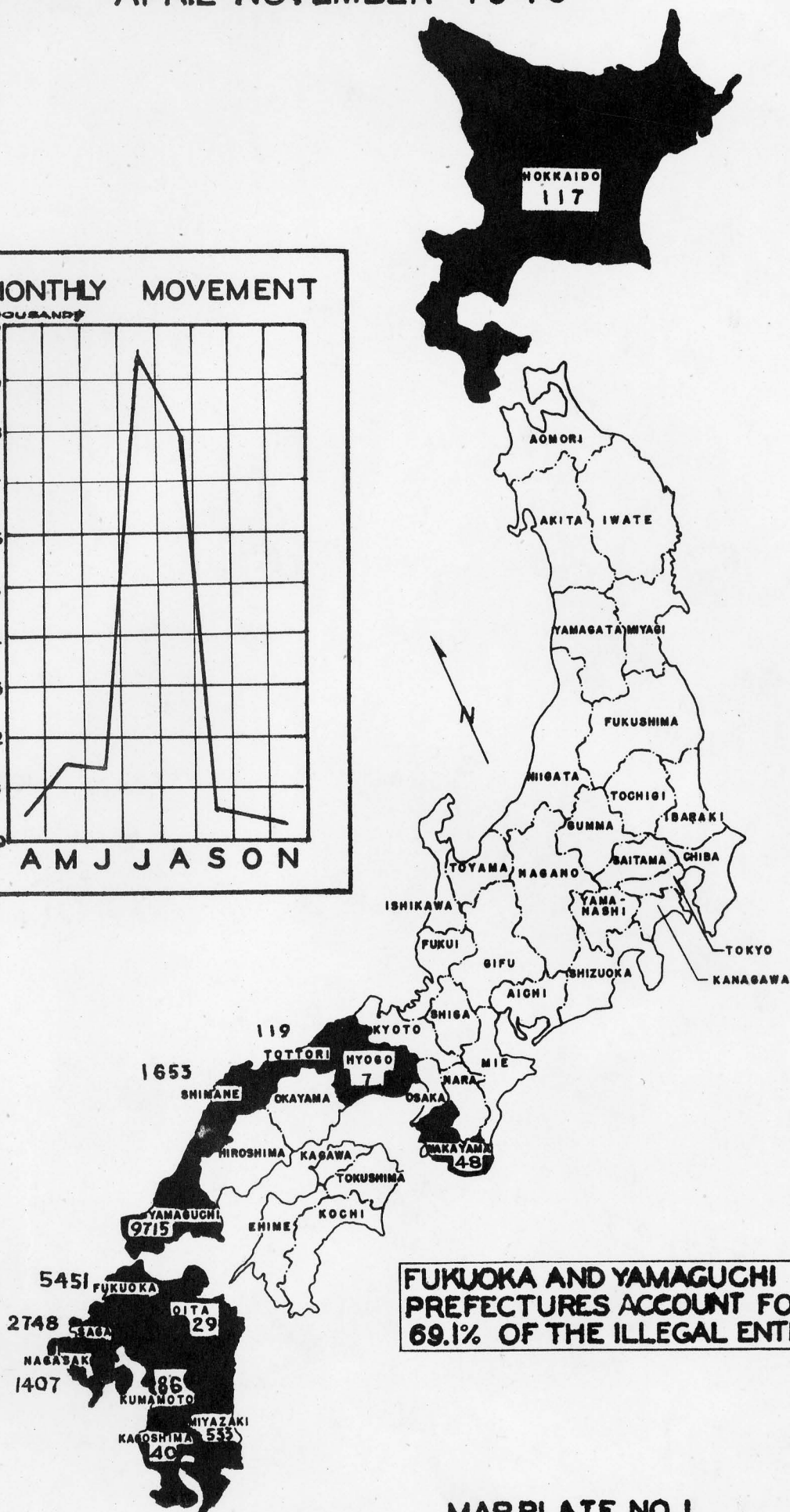
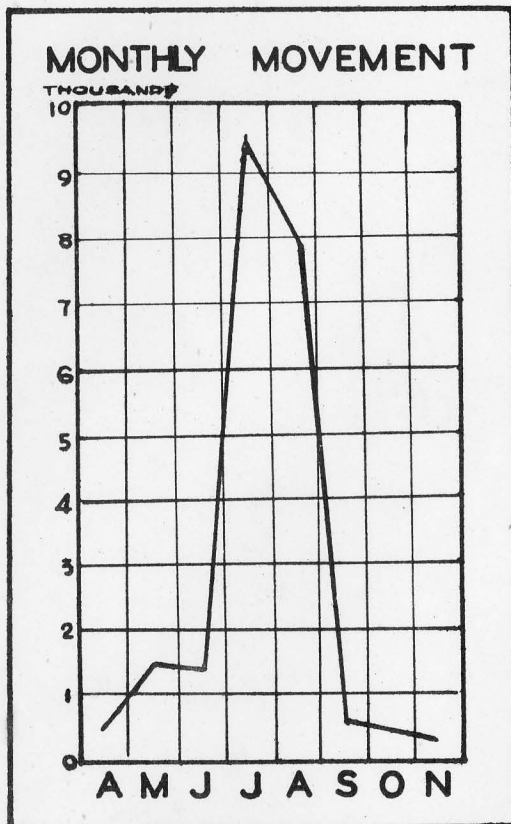

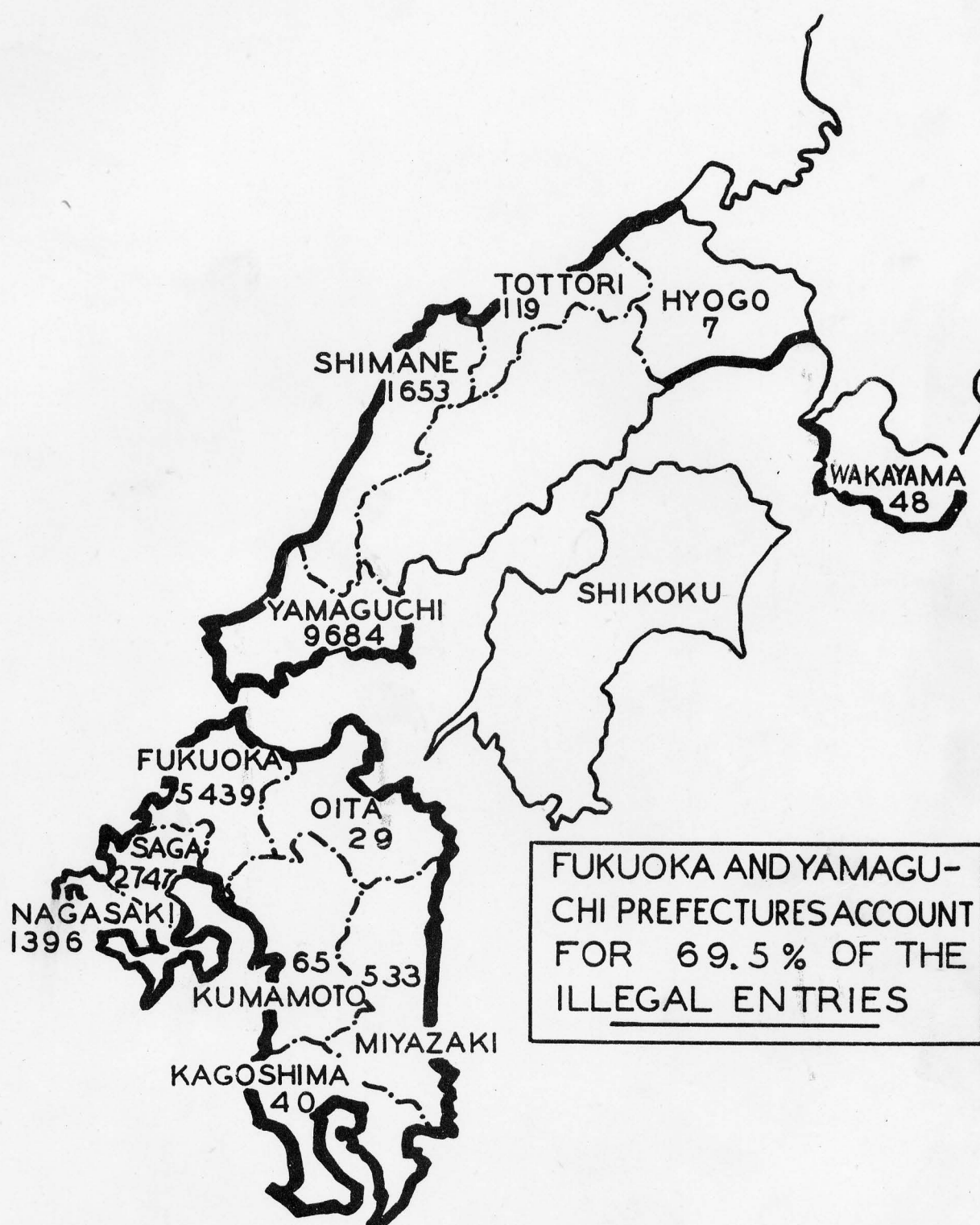
